This event will feature representatives from labor unions and transit agencies, together with FTA and the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), to share practices and answer questions in support of the implementation of the mask requirement on transit systems nationwide. This is the third in a [series of outreach activities](#) to share information and answer industry questions about the federal mask requirement.

The requirement is based on President Biden's [Executive Order 13998](#), issued January 21, 2021. To implement the presidential EO, on Friday, January 29, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention issued an [order](#), and on Sunday, January 31, the TSA issued [Security Directive 1582/84-21-01](#).
