COLUMBUS, Ohio – The Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) will launch new service on Monday, May 3, restoring 14 express lines as commuters begin to return to the workplace. Timetables for each transit line are available online at [COTA.com](https://www.cota.com).

COTA is also announcing the return of Zoo Bus this summer. Zoo Bus is a popular summer transit service at COTA and an easy way to travel between downtown Columbus and the Columbus Zoo and Aquarium and Zoombezi Bay. Service begins Saturday, May 8 and will continue every weekend in May. Beginning Memorial Day, Zoo Bus will run daily through Labor Day.

COTA makes improvements to its service three times a year, on the first Monday of January, May and September. Improvements include schedule adjustments to improve travel times, new and modified service, as well as construction-related route changes.
